

# School is a cut above the rest

The Brisbane School of Hairdressing allows students to fast track their qualification

BRISBANE School of Hairdressing has won the first ever Queensland Battle of the Colleges for hairdressing students.

The challenge, held in October, was organised by the International Hairstylists Society to showcase student work and give them experience in the competition arena.

Each participating college had three weeks to put together a five minute hair show spectacular which had to be inspired by fashion magazines, music videos, Fashion TV and industry journals. Brisbane School of Hairdressing took inspiration from bright colours, geometric shapes and the idea of wild hairstyles to

create a circus themed entry called Big Spectacular Hairy Circus.

The circus came complete with ringmaster, lions, clowns, acrobats and an elegant tightrope walker.

The Brisbane School of Hairdressing allows students to fast track their hairdressing qualification. Within two weeks of the course students start cutting hair on mannequins, after six weeks they are learning how to colour and at 10 weeks students commence work on the school's salon floor and start building their clientele.
